






"Children wearing attires of prince and princess on the day of Diwali celebration, were looking more gracefull and excited, as it generated a special feeling in tiny hearts."

"Don't stay in the boat when god is calling you to step out on the water." On 17th November 2017 kids of Pre-Primary section were made familiar with the Land Transport.


